THANK YOU for volunteering to help with the Florin Roebig Tampa Bay Blues Festival 2012 on April 13, 14, & 15. We hope you enjoy the event and have lots of fun! Please remember to wear your volunteer wristband which designates you as a volunteer. You may pick up the wristband at the **volunteer tent behind the stage directly to the south of North Shore Pool**. If you know of someone who would like to work with you at the last minute, please feel free to bring them with you to the event. We will gladly place all volunteers.

Charity: Our festival benefits the Pinellas Association for Retarded Children ("PARC").

Location: The Festival is at Vinoy Park, south of North Shore Pool and the baseball field. It is directly on the water (7th Avenue and Bayshore Drive NE, St. Petersburg). Please be prompt, as gates cannot open until all volunteers are in place.

Where to Go Upon Your Arrival: The north end of the festival (between the North Shore Pool and the Stage). A volunteer tent is set up in the parking lot. Please check-in at the volunteer tent.

What to Wear: Please dress comfortably and bring sunscreen. The beer trucks get very messy! Please be sure to bring old shoes that can get wet.

Alcohol: Volunteers may be asked to serve beer & wine or sell beverage tickets for the sale of beer & wine and soft drink products. Please be aware that rules regarding serving beer & wine will be posted at the beer trucks & wine tent. Each volunteer must sign a statement that they have read the City of St. Petersburg's rules regarding this type of vending. **No alcohol can be consumed by volunteers while they are working at the event.** You must show proof of being 21 in order to serve beer & wine.

In the Event of Rain: The show will go on!!!!!!

Times of Event: The gates open approximately one half hour before the first act of the day. Please be prompt - we are counting on you!

Parking: Due to the limited reserved parking area, all volunteers are directed to park wherever they can find a spot. We will attempt to furnish you with a parking pass for parking at North Shore Pool or the Tennis Courts; however, space/passes are limited and we cannot guarantee a spot. You are welcome to park in a city garage (\$5 fee), and take the free shuttle (1st Street pick ups) to the event.

If you have any questions, please direct them to the volunteer coordinator at the back of the venue.
